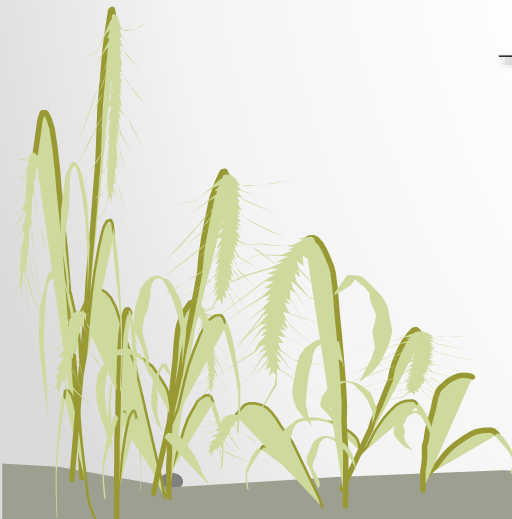


WHEN GOD DOESN'T MAKE SENSE:

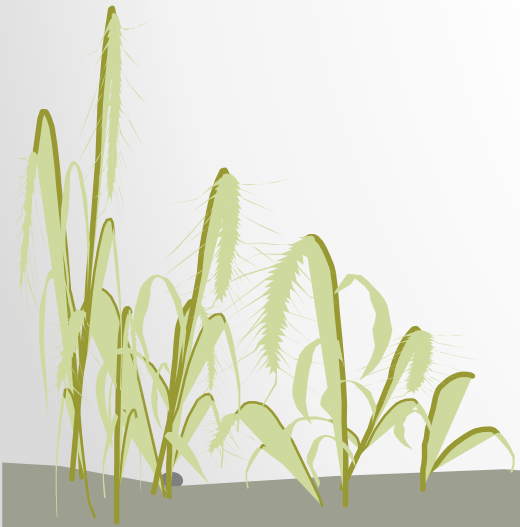
1. True prayer isn't about
