






Genesis 16:1-5a (NLT)

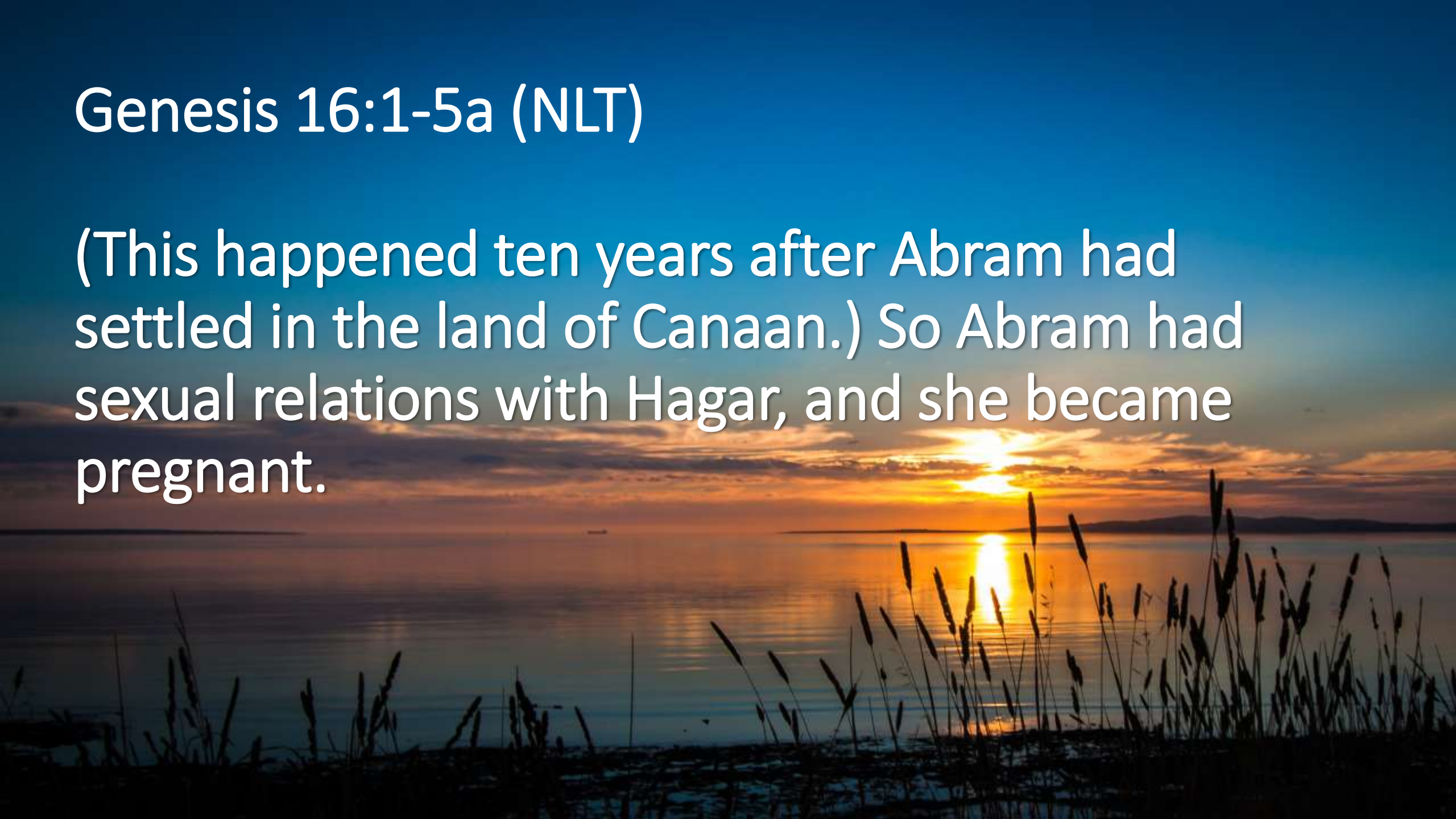




